

## **Gamebox and Scenario Notes:**

Where the scenario calls for units to be placed “within X hexes” of a locale, the units have either been placed in the locale, or adjacent to it if other units are in the way.

For Peninsular War scenarios, units with a non-specific setup location have been placed in the ocean to the side of Spain for players to set up.

Reinforcements: Units set up to arrive at a certain turn have been placed on the Turn Track at the given time. An exception to this: when the schedule calls for “X number of units every turn”, these have NOT been placed on the turn track.

### **Scenario Errata:**

#### 1805 Campaign Game

Poland needs “3C” in pool, but only 2 x 1C” in countermix; have created a third and placed it off to side of box

#### 1813 Scenario:

Italy needs more 1 x “1I” more than countermix can provide (note: the “5” can’t be used in the setup). I left reinforcement schedule 1I shy... casualties could provide extra 1I

#### 1811 Peninsular War Scenario

Need 2 x “1C” Italian cavalry; only 1 in mix. I used a 1 x “1C (H)” cavalry instead

#### 1814 Scenario:

Britain need 2 x “Leader(0)”, only one in mix; I used British Minor “Leader(0)”

Russia need 4 x “Leader(0)”, only three in mix; I used Russian Minor “Leader(0)”

#### 1815 Scenario:

Need 1 x “1C” (N) cavalry; none in mix; I used a 1 x 1C (I) instead.

Counter notes:

I have created an “off-shade” for minor units of each country, with the exception of Austrian, to help distinguish these units and their morale from the regular forces. Consider them the same color as the owning power for the purposes of movement.



In a similar vein, I have created a new pattern for the Guard units. They have a white edge on their corners to help distinguish them from the “regulars” as well.



I have corrected the printing error with the Portugese “P” and “M” counters.

I have created “N” units in Austrian colors.

I have created a host of other units for your use if you desire:

- Tons of optional leaders
- Bavarians in Austrian colors
- Swedes in French colors
- Dutch fleet in French colors
- And more!
